

On November 1st Deputy Investigators made a drug buy and obtained a search warrant for drug dealers on the campus of USAO.

Sunday morning, Sheriff's Investigators observed a drug deal going down by Gregory McPherson in the parking lot of Lawson Court Apartments on the USAO campus. Later the investigators made a drug buy bust with two suspects named Gregory McPherson II of Oklahoma City and Andrew Branch of Friendswood ,

Texas. Investigators purchased 2 half oz. baggies of marijuana revealing cause to obtain a search warrant. Investigators searched the apartment, found 12 small baggies of marijuana, one larger bag containing marijuana, a large



quantity of cash consisting of ones, fives, tens, twenties, and one hundred dollar bills. Sheriff Art Kell said information given to our deputies from the Ninnekah police, was most helpful in this bust. Our department will not tolerate any type of illegal drugs sold, especially on school campuses. If you get caught, to bad for you, as a young person, it will follow you for the rest of your life.

Both suspects are booked into Grady County Jail on charges of distribution of controlled dangerous substance within 1000 ft. of school and possession of controlled dangerous substance with intent.
