VINELINK HAS ARRIVED IN GRADY COUNTY

The Grady County Sheriff's Department has partnered with Vine to bring Victim Notification to the citizens of Grady County.

VINELink is the online version of VINE (Victim Information and Notification Everyday), the National Victim Notification Network.

This service allows crime victims to obtain timely and reliable information about criminal cases and the custody status of offenders 24 hours a day.

Victims and other concerned citizens can also register to be notified by phone, email or TTY device when an offender's custody status changes.

To use VineLink, go to the Grady County Sheriff website and click on the left margin on the VineLink logo.

Click on the map of Oklahoma. Choose Offender Lookup. Put in the first and last name of the person that is incarcerated in the Grady County Law Enforcement Center.

After the inmate is listed, click on the left icon near their name. You will be able to supply an email address or a phone number. Vine Link will notify you when the inmate leaves this facility so you will be able to track his movement.
